

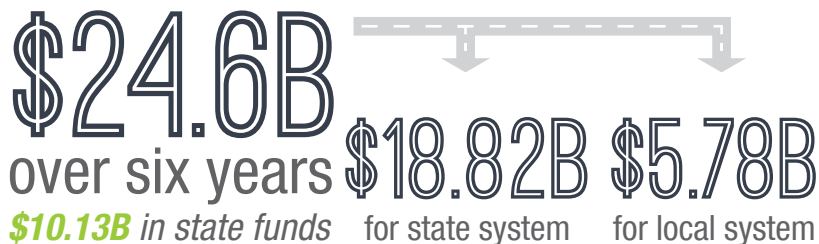

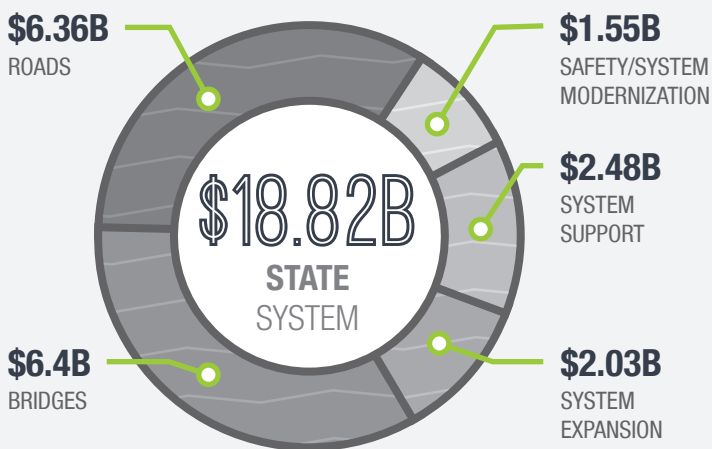
REBUILDING OUR MYP

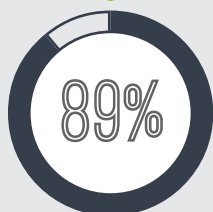

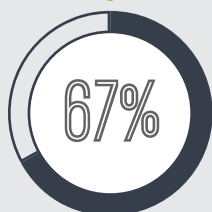

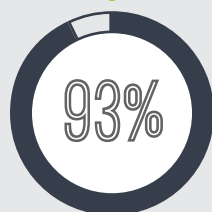

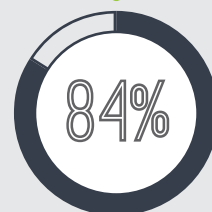


STATE BRIDGES IN ACCEPTABLE CONDITION

MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

CHAMPAIGN

- **U.S. 150:** \$16 million for resurfacing and widening 1.6 miles and other improvements from I-74 Interchange to Illinois 10 in Champaign.

DOUGLAS & CHAMPAIGN

- **I-57:** \$37.1 million for resurfacing on 22.6 miles from the Coles County line to Sadorus Road.

DOUGLAS & EDGAR

- **Illinois 133:** \$16.3 million for resurfacing 26.4 miles from I-57 in Arcola to Illinois 16 in Paris.

EDGAR

- **U.S. 150/Illinois 1:** \$17.5 million for resurfacing 6.5 miles, ADA improvements and guardrail work from Moss Road north of Paris to Gibson Drive south of Paris.

MCLEAN

- **Illinois 9/U.S. 150/U.S. 51 Business:** \$34.9 million for reconstruction of 1.3 miles, resurfacing of 6.2 miles, ADA improvements, curb and gutter, traffic signal replacement and bridge deck overlay from Martin Luther King Drive to Carnahan Drive.
- **I-55:** \$30.2 million for resurfacing 14.5 miles and other improvements from the Logan County line to I-55/74 Interchange in Bloomington.
- **U.S. 51 Business:** \$21 million for resurfacing and widening of 5.1 miles, ADA improvements, traffic signal modernization and other improvements from Gregory Street/Bowles Avenue in Normal to Olive Street in Bloomington.

VERMILION

- **I-74:** \$27 million for resurfacing of 5.3 miles, ramp repairs, bridge replacements, bridge deck overlay and other improvements from US 150/Illinois 1 to the Indiana State line.
